




ABOUT FILM ALULA – YOUR PRODUCTION PARTNER

AlUla offers filmmakers a distinctive range of landscapes, ideal for any genre and capable of doubling for a multitude of locations around the world. From dramatic rock formations and volcanic craters to lush oases and stunning sandstone canyons. The region is a natural filmset just minutes from the town and world-class studios. AlUla features vast deserts, ancient towns, sweeping mountain ranges, and unobstructed night skies.

With 300+ days of blue skies and golden light, AlUla provides endless possibilities for creative filming.


HEGRA: A UNESCO WORLD HERITAGE TREASURE

Hegra, one of AlUla's most significant heritage landmarks, is an ancient Nabatean city spanning 52 hectares. Surrounded by over 100 monumental, beautifully preserved tombs, it holds the distinction of being Saudi Arabia's first UNESCO World Heritage Site.



GHARAMEEL: A GATEWAY TO THE MILKY WAY

Gharameel is home to mystical rock formations that seem to reach up to the Milky Way. This otherworldly location offers a rare, light-pollution-free view of the night sky, where millions of stars are visible to the naked eye, framed by stunning, towering rock formations.



OASES: LUSH HAVENS IN THE DESERT

In the heart of AlUla's desert, vibrant oases with palm groves, natural springs, and diverse flora offer cool shelter. The air is fragrant with dates, citrus, and mint, providing a serene escape at the crossroads of an ancient world.



OLD TOWN: A TIMELESS MAZE OF HISTORY

AlUla's Old Town is the living heartbeat, blending heritage with vibrant modern life. Dating back to the 12th century, is an atmospheric labyrinth of 900 mud brick shops, houses and squares. Overlooked by the 10th-century Musa bin Nusayr Castle, this culturally significant site offers fascinating insights into desert life in Arabia.




MARAYA: A MASTERPIECE REFLECTING ALULA'S BEAUTY

Nestled in Ashar Valley, Maraya is a purpose-built event venue that blends architectural brilliance with AlUla's natural beauty. The world's largest mirrored building, it reflects the desert's grandeur and serves as a world-class venue for events and content production.




SHARAAN NATURE RESERVE: A UNIQUE DESERT ECOSYSTEM

The Royal Commission is dedicated to restoring and protecting AlUla's delicate ecosystem. Within the reserve, a diverse array of species roams freely, including Nubian ibexes, red-necked ostriches, Idmi gazelles, endangered Arabian wolves, foxes, Cape hares, Rock hyrax, and a rich variety of birds.




ALULA RAILWAY: A JOURNEY THROUGH TIME

Built in 1909 CE by Ottoman Sultan Abdulhamid II, the AlUla Railway winds through the historic Wadi AlQura, a valley long tied to travel and exploration. Its embankments pass through AlUla's breathtaking desert landscapes, preserving an important piece of history.



VOLCANIC WONDERS: ALULA'S DRAMATIC LANDSCAPES

In AlUla, black volcanic rock and dormant volcanoes rise from seas of golden sand, creating otherworldly landscapes. Shaped by volcanic activity and erosion over millions of years, these formations have provided natural shelters, influencing the region's historical and cultural significance with their dramatic scenery.



ALULA STUDIOS POWERED BY MBSTUDIOS

AlUla Studios is a state-of-the-art production complex set against the breathtaking landscapes of AlUla. It features two sound stages (25,828 sq. ft. each) supported by dedicated production buildings (17,761 sq. ft.). Operated by MBStudios, a leading global studio services provider, this marks the first partnership of its kind in the region.

The Creative Production Hub at AlUla Studios is designed to support all stages of production and includes workshops, set offices, construction warehouses, prop shops, communal areas, green rooms, dressing rooms, hair and makeup rooms, wardrobe space, executive offices, a boardroom, and a catering facility capable of accommodating up to 400 guests. The site also features a large activation space for events.

AlUla Studios also features world-class audio production facilities, including a 32-piece orchestra space with advanced acoustics and cutting-edge technology. The studios also include meeting rooms, four VIP offices, a private consultation office, and the support of a skilled in-house team. Together, they provide the perfect complement to productions taking place on the sound stages and on-location sets — all set against the breathtaking landscapes of AlUla.





FINANCIAL REBATES & SUPPORT INCENTIVES

Whether you're producing a feature film or TV project, our cash rebates and support incentives are designed to reduce production costs, maximise your budget, and provide comprehensive support throughout your shoot.

Film AlUla offers up to a 40% cash rebate to international, regional, and local film and TV productions, with the rebate elevated to 50% for Saudi nationals.

Support incentives of up to 10% are available for projects that contribute to crew development and training, marketing and promotional activities, enrich local culture and talent both in front of and behind the camera.


SEAMLESS TRAVEL TO ALULA




